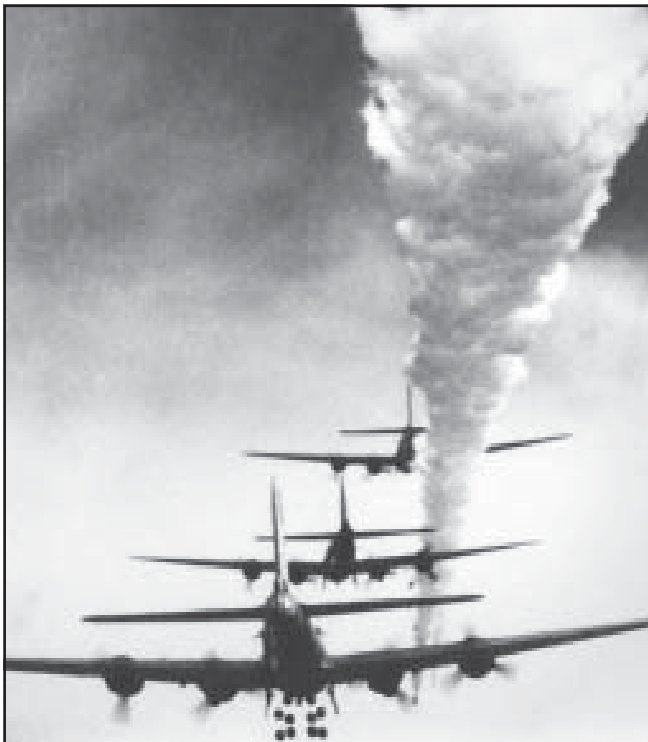

The confused situation on 30th November meant that many aircraft from other groups may have been subjected to and become victims of the flak batteries defending Merseburg. The approach and withdrawal routes for Lutzkendorf, Zeitz and Bohlen brought formations not scheduled to attack Merseburg within their range. The losses shown here are from units known to have attacked Merseburg's Leuna plant.)

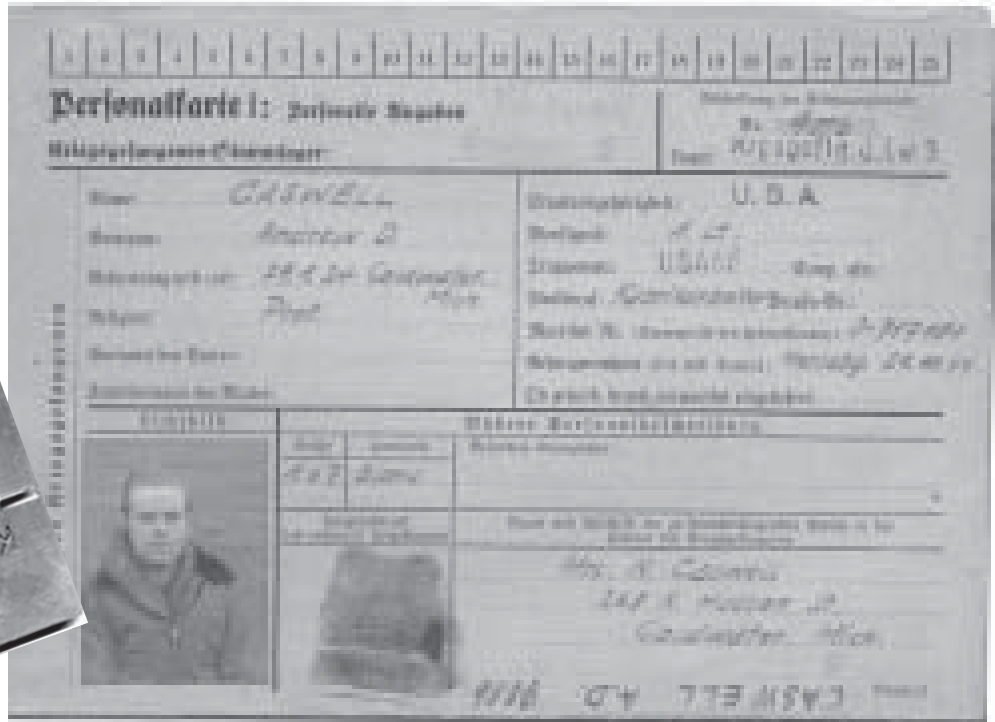
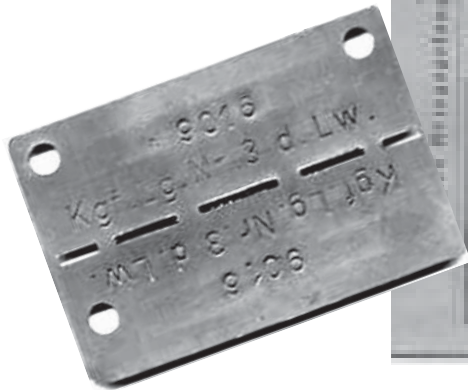
